6. **Restlessness and Growth:** Paradoxically, Francis also speaks of a holy restlessness associated with inner freedom. This restlessness, driven by the Holy Spirit, continually challenges us to deepen our spiritual lives and grow in our relationship with God<sup>[1]</sup>.

By linking these aspects of inner freedom to spiritual growth, Pope Francis presents a holistic view of the Christian spiritual journey, emphasizing the interconnectedness of personal freedom, divine guidance, and spiritual maturation.
